

The WorldKongers Basketball Youth 3 v 3 Tournament Rulebook:

1 - General Overview:

Referees in the WorldKongers Basketball Tournament follow strict rules and guidelines based on the FIBA 3x3 Basketball Rules

2 - "WorldKongers Basketball Tournament Adjustments":

a) Game duration & score limit: 10 minutes running clock playing time & 21 points score limit

b) Shot Clock Implementation: 12 second shot clock will be introduced for the last 2 minutes of the game to ensure games remain competitive and fair.

c) Overtime: First team to score 2 points to win

d) Late Start Penalty: 5 points will be awarded to the opposing team for each minute the late team arrives after the scheduled game start time, beginning 5 minutes past the designated start time. If a team has not arrived after 10 minutes, the team arriving late will concede a forfeit and lose the game.

e) Tiebreaker: If two or more teams finish group play with identical win-loss records, their final standings will be determined strictly by head-to-head results among the tied teams first, followed by overall group statistics if necessary. The tiebreaker criteria will be applied in the following sequential order:

1. Head-to-Head Point Differential: Higher game points difference in the games played strictly between the tied teams.

2. Head-to-Head Points Scored: Higher total game points scored in the games played strictly between the tied teams.

3. Overall Group Point Differential: Higher game points difference across all games played in the group.

4. Overall Group Points Scored: Higher total game points scored across all games played in the group.

3 - Code of Conduct:
